Birth certificates are often needed to receive medical assistance, housing and other public benefits, to obtain a Pennsylvania driver's or non-driver's license, for access to many public buildings, for general identification and many other purposes.

Young adults who attend this free clinic will meet with an advocate who will request birth certificates for them and their minor children free of charge.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **This is a clinic for young adults age 18 to 23 and their children. We cannot request a birth certificate for youth who are under age 18.**
- **Birth certificates requested at this clinic may not be back before December, 2018. PA current processing time is 19 weeks.**
- **HAP does not help individuals obtain PENNDOT identification.**
