CEA-BHRS Evaluation Committee	10-12	Create checks and balances, commit to a continuous improvement process, and develop and implement an evaluation strategy	April	OHS will first target those who participated in initial CEA-BHRS Committee to gauge interest	
Lived Experience Commission	10	Provide a structure for people with lived experience to give feedback on RtH initiatives, progress, and system work that will guide policymaking and direction of future services and needs	April-May for founding membership	OHS will work with providers to identify founding committee	Only persons with lived experience of homelessness
Service Provider Commission	N/A	Ensure opportunities for homeless service providers within the RtH community (HUD-funded and not), to share consistent, meaningful input and solutions-focused feedback related to trends, policy development, system strategy and direction	Always open	Through OHS communications, marketing at events/meetings. Providers can register for Commission through SurveyMonkey	Only homeless service providers
